This training group is the next step after a solid foundational study of TA (usually 2 years) It builds on classical TA models and adds in an educational TA perspective - both in terms of the philosophy of learning and how that translates into the practical application of TA within an educational context (small groups, teams, individuals being coached, schools, teachers, community groups etc) It supports the growing development of your identity as a TA educator. It is a multi-level training group with rich learning across the levels.
